Benefits of Club Adventure:

- Free to those who are eligible for Medicaid services in Erie, Orleans, Genesee and Niagara counties through the Western New York Developmental Disabilities Service Office
- One-to-one staffing available
- A meaningful opportunity to have fun, build friendships and connect with peers

Some scheduled activities are age-specific, otherwise all are welcome.
